Definition of Bulk Waste Generator (BWG)

"Bulk Waste Generator (BWG)" means and includes buildings occupied by the Central government departments or undertakings, local bodies, public sector undertakings or private companies, hospitals, nursing homes, schools, colleges, universities, other educational institutions, hostels, hotels, commercial establishments, markets, places of worship, stadium and sports complexes having an average waste generation rate exceeding 100kg per day or having campus area 5,000 square meters or more.

- Announcement of Shortlisted BWGs for Field Verification in GNIDA website: 8th Jan 2025
- Field verification: 9th Jan 2025 to 20th Jan 2025 (11 days)
- Announcement of Winners : 22nd Jan 2025
- Presenting Awards to winners on 26th January, 2025


